Public Health Outreach Award

Award Purpose: The purpose of the Public Health Outreach Fund is to provide support to a graduate student conducting a community based outreach project designed to address health disparities in Georgia. Support can include, but is not limited to, reimbursing travel and housing expenses in the community where the project is being conducted and/or operational costs to conduct the project. Operational costs can include but are not limited to food, educational, and promotional materials. Funding can also be a cash award to a student’s account for a student conducting the community based outreach project. If this fund is awarded to a UGA employee, and not used to reimburse expenses, it will be awarded through payroll as a special pay and will have tax implications. Scholarship amount: up to \$6000.

Award Criteria: Graduate students in the College of Public Health conducting community based outreach projects designed to address health disparities in Georgia. The student receiving this award will be expected to provide a summary of the project and its outcomes after completion of the project. If this funding is used to support a capstone project, a poster at poster day is a suitable synopsis of the project.

Note: There are potential tax implications associated with this award.
